- 5. All applicants for the University of Alabama scholarship must submit a written letter addressed to the Monsky Scholarship Advisory Committee. This letter should include a personal statement describing the applicant's current and past involvement in Jewish life. Applicants are encouraged to reflect on how their Jewish values, practices, or community participation have shaped their identity and how they hope to continue their engagement with Jewish life during and after their college experience.
